

- What can I expect for the season? Our registration deadline is Mon., Oct 5, 2020. You can register online now, or in person, at our Registration/Clinic events Sat., Oct 3rd 9am-11am or Mon., Oct. 5th 6pm-8pm. The clinic will explain the game rules and shooting tips (at no charge). Shortly after that, a coach will contact you to give you a schedule of the season. Matches will be every Monday night from Oct 19 Nov 23. Depending on how large the league is, time slots could be as early as 5 pm or as late as 8:30 pm. If we have separate divisions, younger students will play first.
- 2. Is it safe? Yes. Since the creation of the Archery Tag[®] brand almost ten years ago, we have seen millions of people around the globe (1,800 locations in 66 countries) who enjoy shooting our bows and arrows. We have NEVER had to file an insurance claim for any injuries, and have never been named in a lawsuit.
- 3. What does the average game look like? Players will play in our arena in a 4 on 4 match. A match will consist of 3 periods, 7 minutes long, with a 3 minute break in between each period. A referee will be scoring the match based on hits, catches, and penalties. Players are not eliminated for being hit, they continue in the match.
- 4. What are the times of the games? This will be dependent on how many students register. Matches will be in 30 minute time slots. Your match could be as early as 5:00 pm and as late as 8:30 pm. Once the teams are formed, a coach will be in contact with you to give you the official schedule.
- 5. Will there be age divisions? This will be dependent on how many students sign up, and the breakdown of their ages.
- 6. Do boys and girls play together? Yes
- **7. Are there practices?** There will not be any organized practices. However, our facility is available to the public on the second and fourth Friday of each month from 6 pm to 10 pm for open play. (\$15 per person for the evening) Everyone is welcome to come in and play to get more experience.
- **8. Do I get guaranteed playing time?** Yes! We play 4 on 4. With teams mostly of 5 or 6 players, everyone should be able to play at least 2 of the 3 periods.
- **9. Do we need to purchase any equipment?** No. Everything needed to play (including masks) will be provided, however we will have official equipment (bows, arrows, & masks) available for purchase. No off-brand equipment (non Archery Tag[®]) is allowed.
- **10.** Is there an end of league final? Yes. All teams will play in the finals.
- **11. How are you handling COVID-19 concerns?** All equipment will be sanitized between games. Only players, coaches, and referees will be allowed into the arena. Spectators will be able to watch the games through the windows of the Event Center. There is plenty of room to maintain social distancing.
